





Sacred Music International Competition 2021 is looking for 8 young singers to be awarded

Semifinals and Final -Gala Concert live in Rome from 15 to 18 September, 2021



2021 Sacred Music International Competition is the 16th edition of the greatest contest in the world dedicated to sacred music solo singers, open to opera singers of all nationalities and all vocal registers "under 37". It is integral part of the cultural project "**Let's Sing Oratorio Music!**" dedicated to spreading the musical genre of the Oratory among European kids, winner of the **Creative Europe Call** and co-financed by the **Creative Europe Program of the European Commission.**



















2021 Sacred Music International Competition will be held with a mixed formula: online for the Eliminatory round by sending a **video by 15 July 2021** - recorded for the occasion or taken from a previous performance - and live in Rome for the Semi-finals and Final - Gala Concert from 15th to 18th September 2021.

The 2021 edition is dedicated to the selection of the **double solo cast for the staging of the show "A Promised Land"** based on arias and choruses taken from Handel's oratories mainly from "Messiah" and "Israel in Egypt" that will be realized during 2022.

The prize roles of the 2021 Sacred Music International Competition are:

- 2 Sopranos or Sopranists
- 2 Mezzo-sopranos, Altos or Countertenors
- 2 Tenors
- 2 Baritone, Bass-Baritone or Bass

All competitors must present 5 arias from the sacred music repertoire of their choice.

The winners of other International Lyric/Opera Competitions will be admitted directly to the Semifinal and their deadline to participate is August 20th.

Prizes 2021

The prizes consist of scholarships for a total of € 10,000.00 offered by the partners of the European project "Let's Sing Oratorio Music": Theater of di Opava (CZ), Filarmonica M. Jora of Bacau (RO), Panhellenic Federation of School Choirs and of the Choirs Directors (GR) and Accademia Musicale Europea (IT), organizer of the Competition, free workshops, trophies, reimbursement of travel and accommodation expenses for all activities and performances.
